Born Robert Zimmerman on 5/24/1941 in Duluth, Minnesota; raised in Hibbing, Minnesota. Highly influential, legendary singer/songwriter/guitarist/harmonica player. Innovator of folk-rock style. Took stage name from poet Dylan Thomas. To New York City in December 1960. Worked Greenwich Village folk clubs. Signed to Columbia Records in October 1961. Motorcycle crash on 7/29/1966 led to short retirement. Subject of documentaries <i>Don't Look Back</i> and <i>Eat The Document</i> . Acted in movies <i>Pat Garrett And Billy The Kid</i> , <i>Renaldo And Clara</i> (also directed) and <i>Hearts Of Fire</i> . Newly-found Christian faith reflected in his recordings of 1979-81. Member of the supergroup Traveling Wilburys . His son Jakob is lead singer of The Wallflowers .

Hard-rock group formed in Los Angeles, California: William "Axl Rose" Bailey (vocals; born on 2/6/1962), Saul "Slash" Hudson (born on 7/23/1965) and Jeffrey "Izzy Stradlin" Isbell (born on 4/8/1962; guitars), Michael "Duff" McKagan (bass; born on 2/5/1964) and Steven Adler (drums; born on 1/22/1965). Axl Rose married Erin Everly (daughter of Don Everly of The Everly Brothers) on 4/27/1990; she filed for divorce three weeks later. Adler left in 1990; replaced by Matt Sorum (who had toured with The Cult). Keyboardist Dizzy Reed joined in 1990. Stradlin left in late 1991; replaced by Gilby Clarke (of Kill For Thrills). Slash was married to model Renee Surran from 1992-97. Clarke left band in January 1995. Slash, Sorum and Clarke recorded in 1995 in Slash's Snakepit.
