Hard-rock band formed in Pasadena, California: **David Lee Roth** (vocals; born on 10/10/1955), Eddie Van Halen (guitar; born on 1/26/1955; died of cancer on 10/6/2020, age 65), Michael Anthony (bass; born on 6/20/1954) and Alex Van Halen (drums; born on 5/8/1953). The Van Halen brothers were born in Nijmegen, Netherlands; moved to Pasadena in 1968. **Sammy Hagar** replaced Roth as lead singer in 1985. Eddie was married to actress Valerie Bertinelli from 1981-2007. Hagar left in June 1996. Gary Cherone (of **Extreme**) joined as lead singer in September 1996 (left after *Van Halen III* album). Anthony left in 2006; replaced by Eddie's son Wolfgang Van Halen (born on 3/16/1991). Roth rejoined group starting in 2007. Hagar and Anthony formed band **Chickenfoot** in 2009.
