First recorded for Sun in 1954. His backing group included The Jordanaires (vocals), Scotty Moore (guitar), Bill Black (bass) and D.J. Fontana (drums). Starred in 31 movies (beginning with <i>Love Me Tender</i> in 1956). In U.S. Army from 1958-60. Married to Priscilla Beaulieu from 1967-73. Their only child, Lisa Marie (born on 2/1/1968), was married to Michael Jackson from 1994-96. Elvis's last "live" performance was in Indianapolis on 6/26/1977. Won Grammy's Lifetime Achievement Award in 1971. Inducted into the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame in 1986.</p>

CHRISTMAS / HOLIDAY SONGS TIMELINE

1934-2003

This timeline of Christmas/Holiday songs begins in 1934, when two standards were introduced after a long drought of fresh new holiday songs. These two 1934 tunes ushered in the golden era of wonderful secular holiday songs. For this listing, a recording (such as Bing Crosby's version of "White Christmas") is only shown in the year it first charted. Shaded titles had a minimum of six separate entries or were top 10 hits on the "Hot 100" or top 3 hits on the Early Pop charts or #1 on the "Country," "R&B," "Adult Contemporary" or "Christmas" charts.

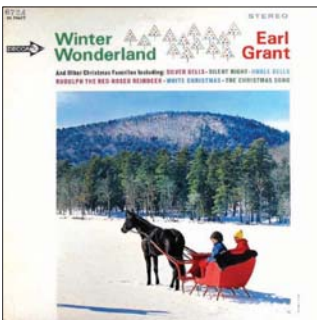

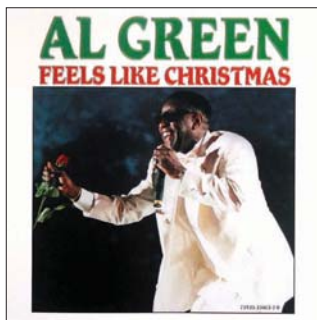
